



A Barn in the Barossa is situated in Kapunda, one hour's drive from Adelaide airport. Door to door delivery is available by prebooked airport shuttle. Over a century ago Kapunda flourished as a copper mining town. The mining period left behind a wealth of historic, majestic buildings and churches set amid rolling hills of cropping land. The town has many beautiful walks, an artist studio trail of five artists which include Jacqueline Coates painting studio and Salon Rouge Gallery, two antique shops, two cafes, an excellent museum, a visitor information centre, several pubs, a library and community art gallery. Kapunda is close to the wineries of the Barossa and 40 minutes from the Clare Valley. Painting tuition with Jacqueline is available during your stay by request. The barn is available for special occasion function hire. Special rates for couples, group bookings and extended stays. Minimum two night booking.
